Policy - Financial Support for Student Representation at Extra-Curricular Events

Introduction:

The Mission Statement of St Stephen's Catholic College encourages all students to build successful relationships, communicate effectively and achieve their personal best. This can be achieved through participation in extra-curricular activities.

Financial guidelines:

- 1. All extra-curricular participation must be approved by the college principal
- 2. If the student/team is successful at the local level, the college will continue to support the endeavour up to and including State Level Competition
- 3. Support may include teacher supervision, transport assistance, accommodation and registration fees; the level of support will be determined on a case by case basis
- 4. If the student/team reaches a National or International level it will be up to the parents to bear all costs. The college may assist with fundraising efforts and staff supervision, which will be determined on a case by case basis.

Note:

This policy relates to students who **directly** represent St Stephen's Catholic College at an event, either individually, or as part of a team. (It does not apply to students from St Stephen's who are selected as members of a district, regional or state team).
