Borrowing Textbooks

Years 8 - 11

Textbooks may be borrowed during Week 0 - the week before school commences during the hours of 9am - 2pm from the library.

Year 7

Textbooks will be borrowed during the first week of school during the library induction period.

Year 12

Students will have been issued with textbooks from the previous year.

Textbooks will be available for borrowing during Week 1 in the student's own time. This is before school, recess 1 and recess 2.

Keep books in your possession. Do not lend your books to other students - books checked out in your name are your responsibility.
